Spectacular

Stockholm Waterfront Congress Centre is Sweden's newest and most versatile venue for large-scale meetings and events. Located in the heart of Stockholm, across the water from the City Hall, the modern architecture is a spectacular addition to the city skyline.

Everything you need

Stockholm Waterfront is located between the Central Railway Station and the City Hall – host to the annual Noble prize dinner. That means easy access to some of the best shops, restaurants and sights in Stockholm. Within a radius of 300 metres there are some 4 800 hotel rooms. Directly connected to the congress centre is the Radisson Blu Waterfront Hotel, a 414 room international first class hotel. The railway station and the Arlanda Express train platform are easily accessible by escalator right next to the congress centre.

Designed to bring the walls up – or down

Stockholm Waterfront Congress Centre comprises 14 000 m² of meeting and exhibition space. You'll find meetings facilities offering daylight and advanced supporting technology. You'll also find a flexibility that is hard to beat. Among other things, our moveable walls can be set up in any number of ways to create the perfect venue or combination of venues. You'll find an auditorium for up to 3 000 people as well as a range of smaller conference rooms. The foyer area represents an additional 3 000 m² of possibilities, whether you are hosting a select business meeting, an exhibition, a gala dinner, or even a sports event or concert.

And then there is the water

The congress centre is built right on the edge of the water. It offers impressive views overlooking Lake Mälaren. Across the waterway in one direction you can see the City Hall and in the other direction you'll see the Old Town and Parliament. And should you want to get closer still, the waters of Stockholm are some of the cleanest in the world which means you can go swimming or fishing right in the city centre.

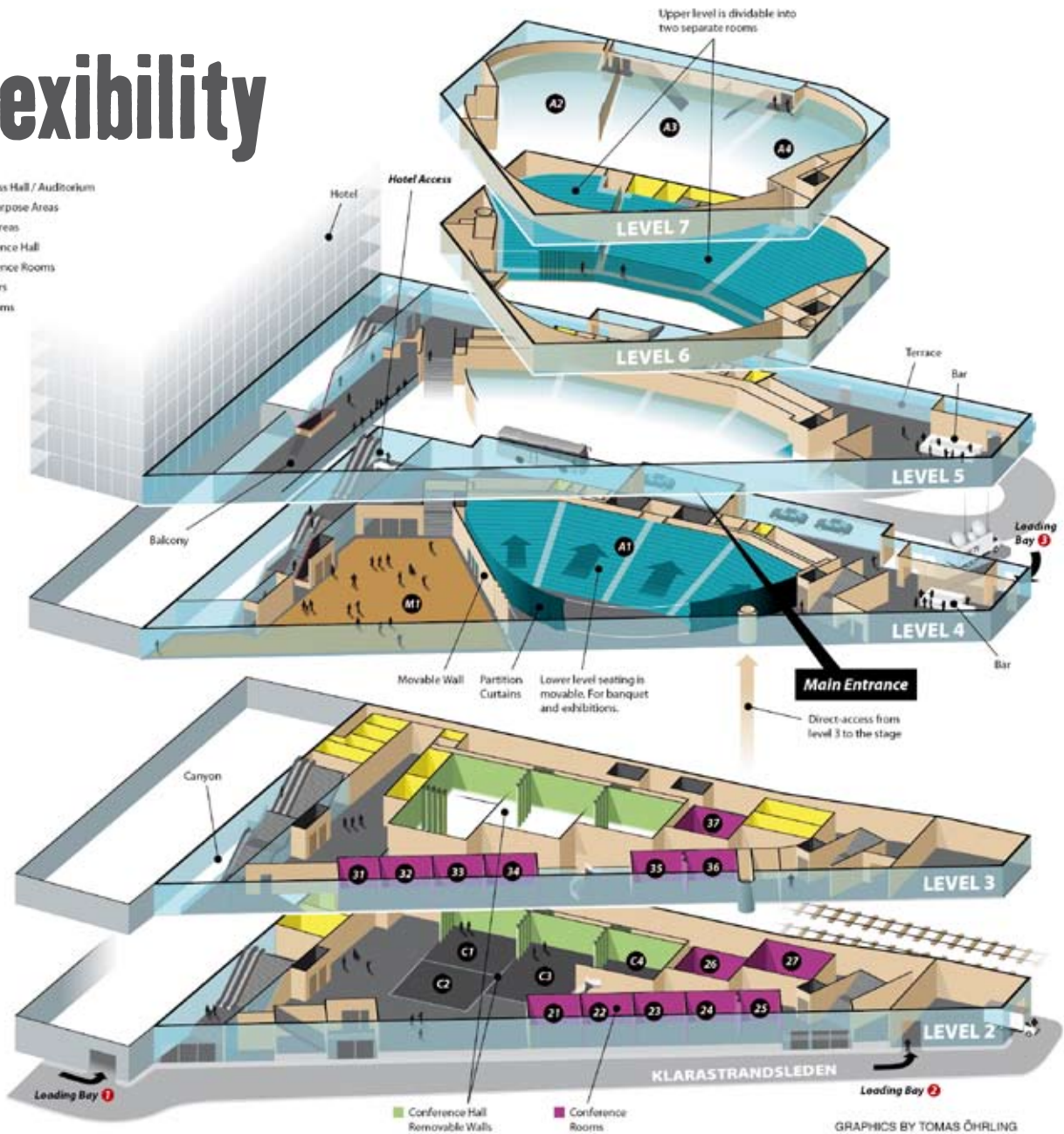
Stockholm

Facts

Exhilarating architecture

- 21 kilometres of stainless steel bars crown the top of the congress building. A spectacular addition to the city's skyline, it's already been dubbed "the Crown of Lake Mälaren".
- 14 000 m² of flexible sectioning solutions allowing a vast number of floor plan combinations – for 500, 1 000 or 3 000 people.
- Stone, steel and glass dominate the building. Scandinavian design at its best.

Greener than green

- Stockholm Waterfront is more than twice as energy efficient as the EU standard "Green Building".
- The glass façades are 1 040 m² solar collectors that on average gather 1 MW of heat energy on a daily basis. This is equivalent to 90 000 normal low energy bulbs.
- The building is cooled by water drawn from the lake, stored in 250 tonne of ice tanks in the basement.
- About 20 000 m² of material has been reused from the building previously occupying the site.

The most central location

- Enjoy panoramic views over the waters of Lake Mälaren, the City Hall and most of the capital city.
- Escalators next to the building connect to both the airport shuttle train and subway platforms at the Central Railway Station.
- There are some 4 800 hotel rooms within a radius of 300 metres from the congress centre.
- The adjoining Radisson Blu Waterfront Hotel is an international first class hotel offering 414 comfortable and well equipped rooms and an all-day restaurant and bar.
